

Please know you are not alone. Our teachers and staff are here to support either through google meets, hangouts, office hours, email, phone calls and more.

Please know we are doing attendance a little differently now that we are in the home learning environment. Our teachers are continuing to mark it daily but it is based on the following guideline from BVSD:

We understand the need for flexibility with attendance. Please make sure to connect with your teachers in these circumstances. They will be tracking student engagement to ensure participation and will check-in with students as often as possible. Students will not be penalized if they are unable to access content or technology.

If teachers and staff notice that a student has not been engaging with home learning, we will reach out and identify how we can support your child. Each grade level has a support team of paras and front office personnel. One of the many things they will be doing is to communicate with families and find solutions if they are struggling with student engagement in the new setting.

The Food Services team has resumed the distribution of food bags this week. Food bags will be distributed on Tuesdays and Thursdays from 11:30am-1:30pm at the same 9 distribution sites for the remainder of the school closures. Click here for more info
